

Steps to Starting a New 4-H Club

Fulton & Montgomery Counties

1. Acknowledge benefits of 4-H club experience for youth.
2. Contact 4-H Staff and ask “How can I start a 4-H club?”
3. Attend 4-H Club Interest Meeting or interview with 4-H staff.
4. Decide to volunteer as a 4-H Club Organizational Leader.
5. Contact parents/guardians of 4-H age youth to recruit members.
6. Recruit at least one other adult to help lead the club.
7. Complete CCEFM VIP (Volunteer Involvement Policy) and 4-H Volunteer Application Process.
8. Schedule date, time and location for 4-H Club Organizational Meeting.
9. Get New 4-H Club Leader Orientation from 4-H staff member(s).
10. Host 4-H Club Organizational Meeting with 4-H staff assistance.
11. Host first meeting of your new club with 4-H staff assistance.
12. Complete necessary club and member enrollment paperwork.
13. Distribute club calendar plans to all families in 4-H club.
14. Participate in four 4-H Volunteer Team Meetings each year and 4-H project subject matter and process skills workshops when offered.
15. Contact 4-H staff for support and information anytime.
