

## Application for 4-H Cloverbud Club Charter

At the conclusion of a 4-H Cloverbud Club's first year, if the club has met the four requirements listed below, the organizational leader should apply for a 4-H Club Charter to become an official 4-H club. Complete the application at the bottom of this page, signed by the organizational leader and one other local leader. It should be filled out with the name of the club exactly as it should appear on the charter. Submit the form to the 4-H office on or before September 30 or as soon as all requirements have been met. A club receives a Club Charter only once.

### Requirements for a 4-H Cloverbud Club Charter

1. The club must have a membership of five or more youth.
2. The club must have an organizational leader and at least one other leader.
3. The club must have identified goals for the year.
4. The club must plan and adopt a program for the year.
