

Application for 4-H Cloverbud Club Seal of Achievement

At the conclusion of a 4-H year, if the club has met the four requirements listed below, the organizational leader should apply for a 4-H Club Seal of Achievement to be placed on the Club Charter. Complete the application at the bottom of this page, signed by the organizational leader and one other local leader. It should be filled out with the name of the club exactly as it appears on the Club Charter. Submit the form to the 4-H office on or before September 30 or as soon as all requirements have been met. A club may receive a Seal of Achievement each year it meets the requirements.

Requirements for a 4-H Cloverbud Club Seal of Achievement

1. The club must have held six or more regular meetings during the 4-H year with a local leader completing monthly reports.
2. Every member of the club, an organizational leader and at least one other leader must be enrolled in the 4-H office by June 1 of the current 4-H year.
3. The club must have put on an exhibit of its work to parents or others.
4. At least 60% of the members in the club must have satisfactorily completed the year.
